Hector Richard Ortiz, Ph.D., DTM



Dr. Hector Ortiz is the Program Manager for Diversity and Inclusion at Penn State Health System. Previously, Dr. Ortiz served as Senior Director of Community Engagement and Partnerships, at the Office of Advancement and Strategic Initiatives, at Central Penn College. From 2015 to 2020, Dr. Ortiz served at Central Penn College as an assistant professor and Director of Graduate Studies. From 2011 to 2015, Dr. Ortiz was Director of the Office of Health Equity, Pennsylvania Department of Health.

Hector is a leadership Harrisburg Area graduate, class of 2005. Hector holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering, a master's degree in diplomacy, and a doctorate in international relations from Guayaquil State

University. Dr. Ortiz also received an honorary-causes doctorate in public service, from Central Penn College in 2011 and obtained the Highest Toastmaster Educational Award, and the Distinguished Toastmaster (DTM) recognition in 2018.

Hector has obtained the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in the Workplace Certificate from the University of South Florida (2021), the Inclusive and Ethical Leadership Certificate from the University of South Florida, Muma College of Business (2023), and the Healthcare Operations Management from Cornell University (2024). Dr. Hector Ortiz is the founder of several Latino organizations and served for more than a decade on the Harrisburg Area Community College Board of Trustees. Hector serves on various local and national boards and committees. He is the founder and former president of Estamos Unidos de Pennsylvania, a grassroots not-for-profit organization created to promote cultural awareness and post-secondary opportunities for children. He is the co-founder and former president of the Latino/Hispanic Professional Association of Central PA, the co-founder and former charter president of the Latino Hispanic American Community Center, and the founder of the Dauphin County Diversity Forum. He is also a charter member of the Rotary Club of Harrisburg Keystone and served as District Governor of Rotary International, District 7390 (2013-2014. Hector has been in Toastmasters since 2011 and has served as Club President, Area Director, Division-A Director, and District New Club Resource (2019-2020) of Toastmasters International, District 38.

Dr. Ortiz has served on the National Association of Community Colleges (ACCT) Board of Directors, Chair of the National Association of Latino Community College Trustees and serves in the board of Keystone Human Services. Hector has attended and presented at several conferences, symposiums, and summits. Hector has received government and community awards.

Dr. Ortiz is the President of H & R Communications and Consulting Services. He is an inspirational speaker and a consultant in diversity, leadership development, communication, and translation/interpretation services Dr. Ortiz is the author of The Creative Energy of Positive Thinking: A Basic Approach to the Genuine Concept of Happiness and Six Assets to Grow Personally and Advance Professionally.
